Start of school arrangements

Please note the bell rings at 8.50am and children will be taken into class by school staff at this time. Doors remain open for a few minutes but we are noticing many children are arriving nearer 9am (or later) at the moment. Children who arrive after the doors close will need to be taken to the office to sign in as they will have missed registration.

Children on the playground in the morning, waiting with parents, will be joined by breakfast provision children and staff. Please could we ask that families wait inside the yellow lines so we can keep the gate area clear. Thank you.

Sports Day

Currently the weather looks dry so sports day will go ahead next Wednesday. In the unlikely event of rain, we will reschedule for 30.06.22

All children should come to school in their PE kits please.

- Nursery - Parents are able to enter the school grounds from 9am via the Nursery entrance. Ms Shalom will direct you where to sit and where to leave your children.

There is no afternoon nursery on sports day. Nursery families are welcome to come along to the afternoon to watch the rest of the school.

- Reception-Y6 - Parents are able to enter the school grounds from 1pm with the sports day starting at 1.15pm. QR codes will be displayed for you to scan for a programme of events. We kindly ask that parents stay within the roped areas. We will take the children back to class before dismissing them at the end of sports day. Due to the number of people on site we will not be able to dismiss any pupils before the end of sports day. Staff will dismiss from classroom doors as usual with the exception of Y1 who will dismiss from the ramp as they did for the Jubilee.
- Refreshments - we will be selling refreshments for adults priced from 50p to £1. We can only accept cash, please bring loose change!

Hot weather

Children have the opportunity to refill water bottles in school but please can you ensure they all have plenty to drink especially for sports day. We also ask that the children wear a cap/hat and have suncream applied before school.
